Additionally, the company has completed more than twenty (20) consecutive months without a recordable injury, and has not suffered an injury resulting in days away from work for over 1.2 million exposure hours, which have been primarily in the hazardous offshore work environment.

Although this record is impressive, Aqueos maintains a perpetual goal of Zero Incidents Performance and views the future as an opportunity for continuous improvement. The goal includes keeping personnel injury free, motor vehicle accident free, regulatory citation free, as well as responsible stewardship of the environment by controlling air pollution, eliminating spills and proper waste management.
